Pastor's Pen

A very cold February is departing and March arrives with the hope of Spring. Not coincidentally, "Lent" is derived from the Anglo-Saxon words lencten and lenctentid, meaning "Spring" and "Springtide" respectively. This also gives a sense of what Lent is intended to be about: preparation for new life in Jesus Christ our Lord by confronting our sin, deepening our devotion, and ordering our lives to best follow Him.

With this in mind, I am happy to announce a few things. First, as long as the county COVID-19 positivity rate remains below 5%, we will resume socially distanced, masked worship on March 7th. Wear your mask (consider doubling up), sanitize your hands, and gather for 9AM worship. We will continue with online worship, and I am pleased to say we have added this feature to our website, stpaulsdansville.org, meaning those without Facebook accounts can engage our service.

Second, beginning Wednesday, March 10, we will have an Adult Forum in a hybrid setting: a handful (preferably 10) will gather in person at St. Peter's fellowship hall for a class that will be streamed via the Zoom app to those who wish to connect from elsewhere. This 15-session course will meet every other week for 15 sessions. The topic is "Simply Jesus," and we will take an in-depth look at the life and context of Jesus Christ, aided by the scholar bishop N.T. Wright. All you need is a Bible, and we

will announce the assigned reading one week in advance to give you plenty of time to prepare.

Third, we have planned worship opportunities for Holy Week provided the county positivity rate remains below 5%. The Palm Sunday procession is back this year on March 28, as is the Good Friday Cross Walk at noon on April 2. That will be followed by a Good Friday service at 7PM. We anticipate having at least one in-person Easter service. Details on that service will be released once approved by Council.

Speaking of Council, with their approval the Youth Group will resume safe gatherings in March. Stay tuned for additional announcements once the volunteers have completed their planning for this.


